

Housing Rights and Women Legal education Course

AIMS: This course aims to build **basic legal knowledge, skills and confidence** to deal with private landlords and local councils on issues of housing and homelessness. We will focus particularly on issues women face in securing and maintaining tenancies.

The course is **for grassroots and community groups** who support women living in precarious housing situations. The course provides basic legal knowledge and is suitable for people with no prior training on housing law.

Saturday 2 nd May 10am—3pm	Living in temporary accommodation
